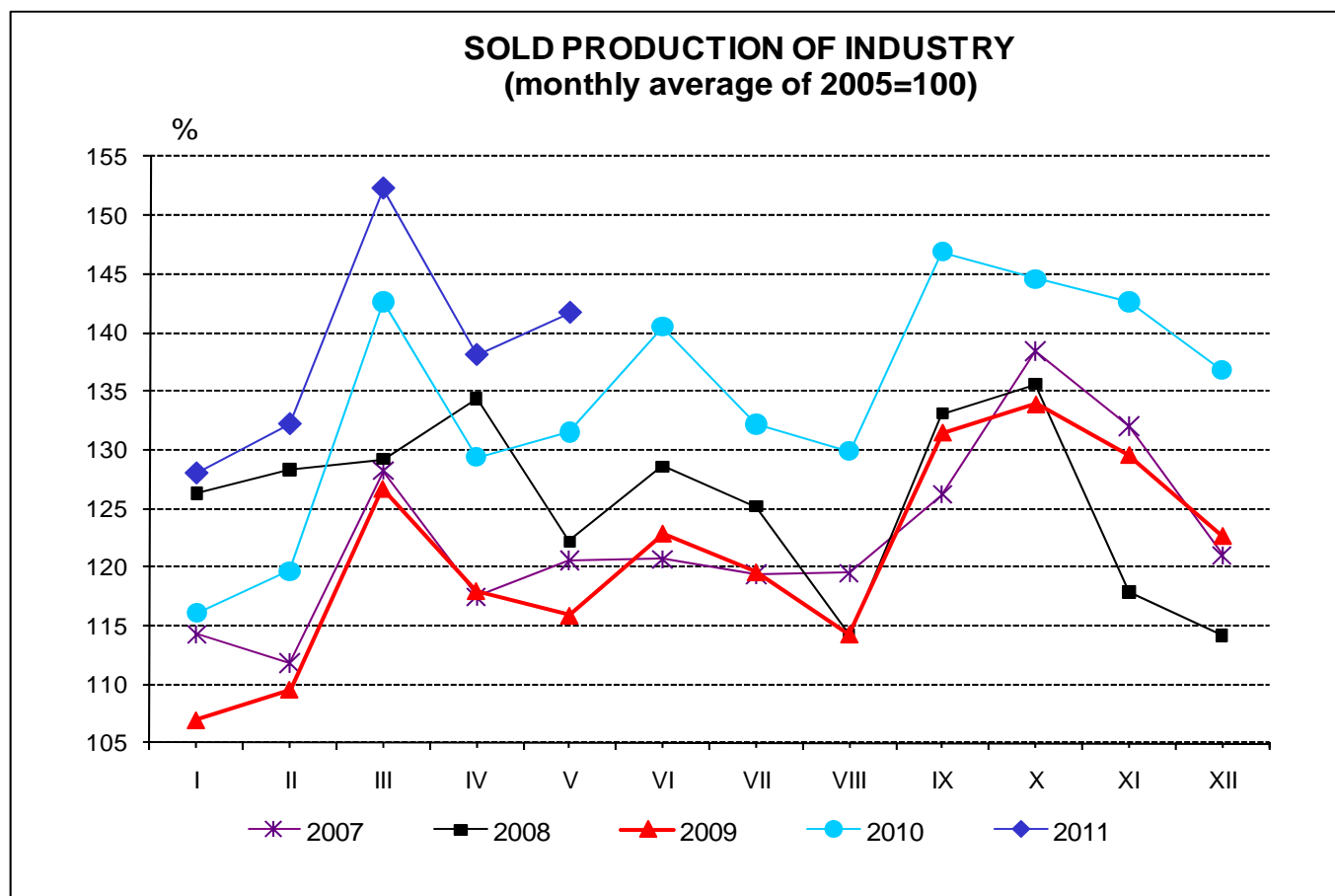

According to the preliminary data **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in May 2011 was by 7.7% higher than in the previous year and by 2.6% higher than in April 2011. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 8.7% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 1.7% than in April 2011.

As compared to May 2010, an increase in sold production was reported in 25 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 26.8%, manufacture of furniture – by 24.1%, manufacture of metal products – by 22.2%, manufacture of basic metals – by 18.6%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 15.7% and manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 15.4%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to May 2010, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 21.1%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 6.2%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 3.4% and manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 0.3%.

In the period January-May 2011 sold production of industry was by 8.5% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 are presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair work, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons in May of 2011 was by 23.9% higher than in the previous year and by 25.9% higher than in April of 2011. After eliminating the seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 18.5% higher than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 3.7% higher in comparison to April of 2011.

In comparison to May of the previous year and April of this year, an increase of production was recorded in all divisions of construction. As compared to May of the previous year, in entities dealing mainly with civil engineering, production increased by 49.9%, and in enterprises whose basic type of activity is specialized construction activities – by 30.5%, while in entities performing mainly construction of buildings – by 2.9%.

In comparison to April of 2011, an increase in production in enterprises whose basic type of activity is civil engineering amounted to 36.3%, and in entities performing mainly construction of buildings by 24.5%, while in entities dealing mainly with specialised construction activities by 14.0%.

The level of construction and assembly production realised in the period January-May of 2011 was by 19.3% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.
